
Hon'ble Supreme Court's Guidelines

to the Police and Administration to ensure safe exercise of Right to Choice in Marriage



The Supreme Court of India has directed the administration / police authorities throughout the country to ensure that —

If any boy or girl who is a major undergoes inter-caste or inter-religious marriage with a woman or man who is a major, the couple are not harassed by any one nor subjected to threats or acts of violence.

any one who gives such threats or harasses or commits acts of violence either himself or at his instigation, is taken to task by instituting criminal proceedings by the police against such persons and further stern action is taken against such persons as provided by law.
