### Legal Provisions Against Cyber Crimes

#### <u>Information Technology Act, 2000</u>

**Section 66E:** Capturing, publishing, or sharing images of a person's private areas without consent.

Section 67A: Publishing or transmitting sexually explicit content.

Section 67B: Publishing or transmitting child pornography.

#### Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (POCSO)

**Section 13:** Any act involving a child in sexually explicit conduct or content. **Section 15(1):** Storing, possessing, or distributing child pornographic material.

#### Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023

**Section 77:** Voyeurism — Capturing images of a woman engaged in a private act without consent.

**Section 78:** Online stalking — Persistent pursuit, online monitoring, or communication against a woman's will.

**Section 79:** Concerns with insulting a woman's modesty through words, gestures, or intrusion on her privacy.
