Legal Provisions Against Cyber Crimes

Information Technology Act, 2000

Section 66E: Capturing, publishing, or sharing images of a person's private areas without consent.

Section 67A: Publishing or transmitting sexually explicit content.

Section 67B: Publishing or transmitting child pornography.

Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (POCSO)

Section 13: Any act involving a child in sexually explicit conduct or content.

Section 15(1): Storing, possessing, or distributing child pornographic material.

Section 77: Voyeurism – Capturing images of a woman engaged in a private act without consent.

Section 78: Online stalking – Persistent pursuit, online monitoring, or communication against a woman's will.

Section 79: Concerns with insulting a woman's modesty through words, gestures, or intrusion on her privacy.
